We continue to be Covid safe and follow the government guidelines. To register this way when you enter the church, you will need to bring a mobile phone.

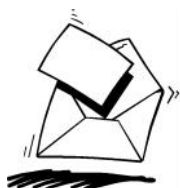
When entering our premises you will see covid safe visit signs in the breezeway and foyer, follow the directions and enter the names of all who visit with you.

Please take. More can be printed.



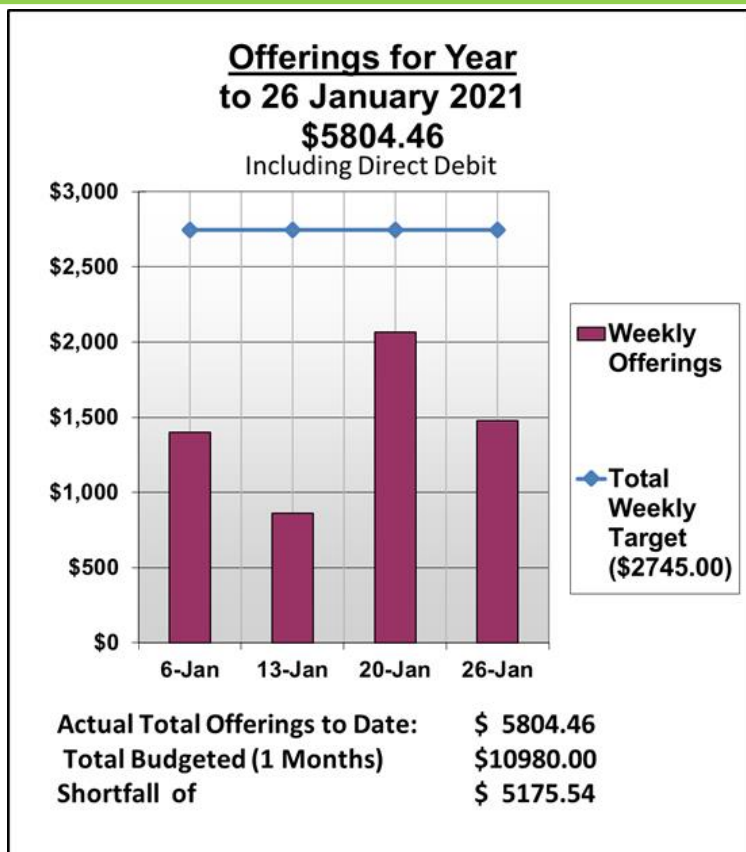
Weekly Offerings Graph

Today we introduce a new item to our Outreach that will appear each week. This graph provided by the Treasurer and Service Stream seeks to ensure that you are kept informed of our financial capacity to maintain ministry.

The graph provides straight forward details on how we are doing, by showing the four previous weeks offerings as red bars. This makes it is easy to compare the totals and if there is a trend (are our offerings going up or down?) Towards the top of the graph is a blue line representing the weekly target approved by the Congregation as part of our budget. In today's graph it is unfortunately clear to see that we are not even close to achieving our weekly budget.

Under the graph are some actual figures: Our Year-to-Date offerings, the projected budget, and our current standing. As of last week, less than a week into the year, we are already over \$5,000 behind budget. Not a good start to the year.

This graph will be updated each week so that members can prayerfully consider the needs of the congregation, and how they can financially contribute to supporting the work of the church. Please pray for the mission and ministry of our church, and that the necessary funds will be sourced to we continue to be a light to our community.
