THE INTERCEDING CHRIST - John 17:20-26.



Prayer is an essential part of our formation as Jesus' disciples, yet it is the hardest thing to maintain. We are comforted and encouraged to know that when we struggle in prayer, we are not alone; the Holy Spirit alongside helper comes as our and Advocate. (Rom 8:27, 28). In Jesus' prayer

for his disciples on the night of his betrayal we hear his deep love and concern for their well-being. He also prayed for all who would come to believe in him in the future - a prayer answered on the day of Pentecost when 3000 new believers were added to the church after hearing Peter's preaching.

In a Lecture in Britain, James Torrance said "...for a proper understanding of prayer, the church needs to recover the biblical teaching of the sole priesthood of Christ, to know that in the suffering, risen and ascended Christ we have someone who stands in for us in the heavens - who knows our suffering, and can do for us and in us, what we try to do and fail to do - one who lives eternally to intercede before the throne of grace for us (see Heb 6:20; 7:25-28 and 8:1-6) - who gives us the gift of the Spirit to share in his intercessions.

To pray is to offer up our desires to God in agreement to His will *in the name of Christ.* We can pray "in the name of Jesus because Christ has already offered up in our name, our desires and needs and concerns - and he continues to offer them for he stands in the gap between God and the people as our Great High Priest."

What might you be going through now that you really need help with? Write it down and lay it before your Lord. See him - praying for you now in that area of need. Thank him for his intercession, trust him to pour out his love and grace into that problem, and then look for new ideas, directions and opportunities that offer a possibility for change. Embrace them, ponder how best to proceed (it's prudent to not plunge in and act rashly - think it through, maybe ask for confirmation) and act on them when you can. We will always do better when we turn our lives over to Jesus, and trust him to help us in our time of need. (from The Word Among us - St Theresa of the Infant Jesus)

As St Francis de la Salle, said, "Prayer is the foundation of our hope, it gives us confidence to approach God knowing that God hears and helps us."

Rev Bruce Moore is the Moderator-elect of the 37th Synod



UnitingCare Queensland Director of Mission, Rev Bruce Moore, has been elected as Moderator-elect of the Uniting Church in Australia, Queensland Synod. Rev Moore will be inducted at the 37th Synod in October 2023.

Speaking about his hope for the Synod, Rev Moore said we are uniquely placed as the Uniting Church here in Queensland.

"We are connected to our far-reaching relationships, lives and communities, and

diverse landscapes like no one else are. My daring hope is that we will not be complacent, will not rest in the comfort of what we've done in the past, what we've inherited," he said.

"When we look back, we will recognise that we have never been in a place where we have so much invitation for change as to where we sit right now. This is one of the most opportune times for spiritual awakening across the globe. People are looking for hope, a point of connection and a deeper understanding of what it means to have a purpose."
