At 9:00am worship in AUC next Sunday, 20 September, we will host people from the Presbytery at an intercultural, multilingual service. People from different ethnic backgrounds will participate.

The 9:00am service on Sunday morning will be part of a Presbytery Intercultural Mission Weekend.

The guest preacher will be Rev Dr Jason Kioa, a Tongan-born Australian and ordained minister in the Uniting Church. He has served in the Uniting Church in Australia since 1990 with various placements including Moderator of the Synod of Victoria and Tasmania (2006-2009), President of the Tongan National Conference and Minister at Mascot Wesley Uniting Church in Sydney - a thriving multi-lingual, intergenerational, inter-cultural congregation, where he served with Rev Brendon Lukin. Jason is Australia's most senior Tongan Minister who is an advisor to Synod and Assembly committees in the Uniting Church and in fellowship and engagement with church leaders throughout the Pacific. Jason's 2020 Doctoral Thesis "The Role of the Tongan National Conference in the Uniting Church in Australia" has been ground-breaking in positioning the Uniting Church in Australia as a intercultural Christian denomination.
